The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by President Carrie Hurich who determined there was a quorum.

Minutes of the June 13, 2015 meeting were approved as read.

President's Report

Carrie welcomed everyone, and explained that membership is voluntary and only \$20.00 a year. She further explained our "chipper" reimbursement program wherein members may be reimbursed \$75.00 toward chipper services with Splintered Forest, J-WARD Industries, and J's Got Wood. She detailed suggested appropriate fire mitigation and that this is just one of the advantages of membership. There was a question on our becoming a Firewise Community and it was explained that becoming a "Firewise Community" would be a very sensible and prudent thing to do; however, it would take many hours of volunteer time to accomplish which we do not presently have in the HOA and in addition, it would require 100% participation.

Trail Work/Park – Jim Aitkenhead updated everyone on the recent road base improvements at the Park beginning at the entry way, to the portapotty, and on up to the trail head. There was also conduit installed for the upcoming electrical work at the Pavilion where motion lights are to be installed. There was discussion about the vandalism problems and we are hoping lights will be a deterrent. Carrie stressed that the Park closes at sundown and we ask anyone who sees anything suspicious or anyone in the Park at night, to call the Sheriff's Office. A "neighborhood watch" would be very helpful.

<u>Guns</u> – We've have many calls and complaints about people shooting in Burland and the fact is that it is legal to shoot in Burland; however, there are rules, and any questions or complaints should be referred to the Sheriff's department.

<u>Fireworks</u> – This is a problem not only around July 4th, but all year. Fireworks are illegal, and any complaints should again, be referred to the Sheriff's department.

<u>Wildlife</u> – Do not feed wildlife. Carrie and Jim explained that many people love to feed corn to deer, however, corn is a "hot" food for them, and actually lethal to their digestive systems, so do not feed the deer. Also, deer

attract mountain lions, so another reason, not to feed them. In addition, if you see a lone fawn, do not bother it, or call the DOW. Mom knows where it is, and she will eventually return.

<u>Bears</u> – Carrie explained that if you're new to the mountains, you may not know that bears have very good memories, and they actually learn when it's trash day! Rule: Do not put your trash out the night before trash day, and always bring in trash cans after the trash has gone.

<u>Marijuana</u> – Carrie stated for the record that the HOA is not and will not become involved with the marijuana issue, for or against, but will only provide information to our residents as it becomes available. The "sides" on marijuana are close, so if you have an opinion for or against, it is suggested that you become involved as this is all sorted out. Also, please send us emails with any information that we may pass on at our meetings.
