Mike Guelker stated he signed a contract with T-Mobile.

We also discussed changing the name, " Burland Civic Association" to " Burland Homeowners Association" due to the fact that some people associate " Civic" as a political organization. Bob Worley stated it wouldn't cost too much money to make this change. We will pursue at a later date.

Shirley Franklin stated she would work on a grant to request funds to finish the basket ball court. Please turn in your volunteer hours to Shirley.

Taryn Guelker will check on getting a surveillance camera as we still have a lot of vandalizm at the Park.

A motion was made and approved that we charge a \$ 50.00 clean up fee for people who reserve the Pavilion and don't clean up the tables and floor after using it. Jean Wagner will draw up a simple contract which will be put into effect starting next year, 2004.

We received over 14 responses regarding LUR Covenants Violation from our special Burlander regarding cleanup day.
