If you plan on leaving for vacation, you can call the sheriff dept to notify them and they will do periodic checks while you are away.

Mike will also invite Fred Wagner to our July meeting. There were some questions about parking on the roads in Burland, and why people are not be ticketed for parking on the road.

#### **Trash**

If you notice that someone's trash is on the ground because they did not put in container, you can call either DOW (because you are feeding wild animals which is prohibited) or sheriff dept.

#### **Shooting Ranges**

Can you shoot weapons in Burland? There are no codes in Park County stating you cannot shoot your gun at a residence!! People are suppose to be careful, but sometimes that does not always work. There are shooting ranges: on PC 64, Harris Park and Slaughter House.
