A question presented to the BHA was could Alltell use motorized vehicles to move equipment up to Mt Bailey? This could not be voted on due to lack of quorum; however, of the four members there, they would allow Alltell the use of motorized vehicles with the understanding that the trail on the back side of Mt Bailey would have to be restored if there was any damage. Cameron will hold an e-mail conference to see if other members would agree to this as he would like to advise Alltell as soon as possible.
